Trustco is a corporation formed under the Canada Business Corporations Act. It is a holding company.

The Management Company is a corporation formed under the Canada Business Corporations Act. It provides management services to the Funds.

The Trustee is a corporation formed under the Manitoba Corporations Act. It is the trustee for the Unitholders of the Funds and serves as the trustee for other open-end mutual fund trusts organized and affiliated with IGI.

The Funds are open-end mutual fund trusts of which the Unitholders are beneficiaries established in accordance with a Declaration of Trust under the laws of Manitoba, Canada.

IGI owns 100% of the issued and outstanding Class A Common Shares of Trustco. Trustco owns 100% of the issued and outstanding Class A Common Shares of the Management Company. Trustco also owns, directly or indirectly,

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100% of the issued and outstanding Common Shares of the Trustee. Trustco, the Management Company, the Trustee, and the Funds are ultimately controlled by IGI through its ownership of 100% of the issued and outstanding Class A Common Shares of Trustco.

Power Financial Corporation owns 54.04% of the common stock of Investors

Group Inc. Power Corporation of Canada, of which Mr. Paul Desmarais controls 64.9% of the voting power, owns 67.5% of the common stock of Power Financial Corporation.
