- (1) Balance includes the following shares acquired through the automatic dividend reinvestment feature of Exelon plans: 569 shares on 3/10/2011; 591 shares on 6/10/2011; 591 shares on 9/9/2011; and 582 shares on 12/9/2011.  
Shares held as of 12/31/2011 in a multi-fund 401(k) Plan to be settled in cash upon the reporting person's termination of employment for any reason on a 1:1 basis. Shares are acquired through regular periodic contributions, company matching contributions, and the automatic reinvestment of dividends.
- (2) Performance Shares awarded pursuant to the Exelon Long Term Incentive Plan. 1/3 of the shares awarded vested immediately upon receipt. The remaining shares vest in 1/3 increments on each of the first and second anniversaries of the grant date. Under certain circumstances some or all of the vested shares may be settled in cash on a 1 for 1 basis based on the cash value of the underlying stock on the date of vesting.
- (3) Balance includes the following shares acquired through the automatic dividend reinvestment feature of Exelon plans: 41 shares on 3/10/2011; 43 shares on 6/10/2011; 43 shares on 9/9/2011; and 42 shares on 12/9/2011.
- (4) Restricted stock units granted under the Issuer's Long Term Incentive Plan. Restricted stock units may be settled on a 1 for 1 basis in shares of Exelon common stock. 100% of the shares will vest on 08/01/2013.
