("Trian ERISA Fund"), Trian Partners Strategic Investment Fund, L.P. ("Strategic Fund"), Trian Partners Strategic Investment Fund-A, L.P. ("Strategic Fund-A") and Trian SPV (SUB) V, L.P. ("Trian SPV" and collectively, the "Trian Entities").
