- (1) Represents the conversion upon vesting of restricted stock units ("RSUs") into common stock. On July 15, 2015, the reporting person was granted 8,333 RSUs that were previously reported on Table II of Form 4, which report was filed with the Securities and Exchange Commission (the "SEC") on July 17, 2015.
 - (2) Represents the conversion upon vesting of RSUs into common stock. On October 5, 2016, the reporting person was granted 3,200 RSUs that were previously reported on Table II of Form 4, which report was filed with the SEC on October 7, 2016.
 - (3) These shares are owned directly by the Jury Bain Superannuation Fund, a retirement fund of which the reporting person is a beneficiary.

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- (4) Each RSU is the economic equivalent of one share of S&W Seed Company common stock. The closing price of SANW on December 30, 2016 (the last trading day before January 1, 2017), which fell on a weekend) was \$4.60.

- (5) On July 15, 2015, the reporting person was granted 8,333 RSUs, of which 643 vested on January 1, 2017. The common stock into which such vested RSUs converted on January 1, 2017 is reported on Table I of this Form 4. The remaining unvested RSUs will continue to vest in quarterly installments on the first day of each fiscal quarter to and including July 1, 2018, subject to the reporting person's continued service with the Issuer on each respective vesting date.

- (6) On October 5, 2016, the reporting person was granted 3,200 RSUs, of which 266 vested on January 1, 2017. The common stock into which such vested RSUs converted on January 1, 2017 is reported on Table I of this Form 4. The remaining unvested RSUs will continue to vest in quarterly installments on the first day of each fiscal quarter to and including October 1, 2019, subject to the reporting person's continued service with the Issuer on each respective vesting date.
