**Item 7.01 Regulation FD Disclosure.**

On May 9, 2016, the Registrant issued a news release announcing that a National Instrument NI 43-101 Technical Report entitled Feasibility Study Nyngan Scandium Project (the **Technical Report**) has been filed on SEDAR on Friday, May 6, 2016. This Feasibility Study on the Registrant's 80% owned Nyngan Scandium Project, supports the technical and economic viability of the Nyngan Scandium Project (the **Project**).

The Technical Report was prepared by Lycopodium Minerals Pty Ltd. (**Lycopodium**) of Brisbane, Australia and was independently compiled for the Registrant in the form prescribed under National Instrument 43-101 Standards by Disclosure for Mineral Projects.
