Item 5. Other Events

Registrant today said that the filing of its year 2000 10-K report would be delayed. This delay relates to an internal review begun last week by Registrant's Audit Committee, in cooperation with Registrant's auditors, KPMG. This will permit a fuller audit review than previously contemplated and a sign-off on the Registrant's 2000 financial statements.

Registrant and its Audit Committee stated that they believe that Registrant's accounting policies and procedures are appropriate and consistent with generally accepted accounting principles. However, in light of the previously disclosed investigation by the Securities and Exchange Commission, the Audit Committee and the auditors believe that a fuller review is appropriate.

KPMG has advised Registrant that it believes that such fuller review is needed for it to satisfy its auditing responsibilities, and that it will work with the Audit Committee and the Committee's counsel to complete the review as quickly as possible.
