- (1) Transaction effected pursuant to a pre-planned trading plan entered into on May 10, 2010, in accordance with Rule 10b5-1 of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934.
- (2) The option became fully exercisable as of February 18, 2007, the third anniversary of the grant date.
- (3) The option became fully exercisable as of February 17, 2008, the third anniversary of the grant date.
- (4) The option became fully exercisable on February 15, 2009, the third anniversary of the grant date.

The cash settlement payable per unit shall be equal the closing stock price per share of the Company's common stock on the Valuation Date as reported on the New York Stock Exchange.
- (13) Each deferred unit will be settled in cash as soon as practicable, and in any event within 90 days, after the second anniversary of the grant date (November 5, 2009) for an amount equal to the Company's closing stock price on the New York Stock Exchange on the settlement date. Deferred units are fully vested when credited.
- (14) Each deferred unit will be settled in cash as soon as practicable, and in any event within 90 days, after the second anniversary of the grant date (February 25, 2010) for an amount equal to the Company's closing stock price on the New York Stock Exchange on the

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settlement date. Deferred units are fully vested when credited.

One-third of the deferred unit award will be settled in cash as soon as practicable after, and in any event within 90 days after, the first, (15) second and third anniversaries of the grant date (May 3, 2010) based on the Company's closing stock price on the New York Stock Exchange on the applicable anniversary date. Deferred units are fully vested when credited.

One-third of the deferred unit award will be settled in cash as soon as practicable, and in any event within 90 days, after the first, second (16) and third anniversaries of the grant date (August 6, 2010) based on the Company's closing stock price on the New York Stock Exchange on the applicable anniversary date. Deferred units are fully vested when credited.
