On June 5, 2013, EZCORP, Inc. delivered a blackout notice to its directors and executive officers informing them of a temporary suspension of transactions relating to the EZCORP stock fund within the EZCORP 401(k) Plan, as a result of the transition of the administration of the plan to a new service provider, and the resulting blackout (a)restrictions imposed on the company’s directors and executive officers. Attached hereto as Exhibit 99.1 and incorporated by reference is a copy of the blackout notice. The company provided the blackout notice to its directors and executive officers in accordance with Rule 104 of the Securities and Exchange Commission’s Regulation BTR.
